

DONATIONS TO THE PERMANENT COLLECTION

Donations to the Collection are a significant way for artists and donors to support the Gallery's mandate in conserving our past, reflecting our present and dreaming the future through the Arts. And we are fortunate in having a world class facility here in Grande Prairie from which we can meet this opportunity.

The Art Gallery of Grande Prairie was designated as a 'Category A' Institution by the Movable Cultural Properties Directorate of Canadian Heritage. This means that due to its strict climate, safety and security controls, the Gallery is permitted to receive art donations of outstanding significance and national importance. The Permanent Collection currently stands at approximately 800 works of art, almost exclusively created in Alberta in the mid to late 20th Century, but it is growing each year. In 2016 alone, 13 new pieces were donated to the Collection.
