

A pattern is a regularity in the world, in nature, in human-made design, or in abstract ideas. As such, the elements of a pattern repeat in a predictable manner. Use the paper provided or use materials found around you to fill in the grid and create a predictable or unpredictable design.

Step 1:

Print out the gridded sheet provided onto cardstock or white paper.

Step 2:

Find patterned or coloured paper, magazine clippings, or draw your own pattern in each square using coloured pencils or markers. If you wish to cut the patterned paper into different shapes you can do that now and create layers on top of other pieces. Do you see a predictable or unpredictable pattern happening?

Step 3:

Once you are happy with your design, start gluing the shapes down.

Step 4:

When you are finished, think about a title for your work. A title can add an interesting element to the work, for both, the artist and the people you share your art with because a title may help communicate your inspiration and reason for creating the artwork.
