

What is a domino?

A domino is a small flat rectangular block made of wood or plastic that has one or more dots on one side and that is used in playing games.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1: Look for Carmen Haakstad's large Domino I-6 forest installation in the Meet the Artist video. Can you find the person he integrated into one of his Domino Tree Paintings? Did you already notice that there are often figures present in his forest paintings?

Step 2: Take the large curvy wooden stick out of your kit. Notice that it has a little bit of a grain to it.

Step 3: Using the materials provided the way they make sense to you, choose your first plasticine colour and flatten the plasticine before you build up the sculptural form of a domino. The curvy stick can be used as a tool to flatten the plasticine or serve as a support for building the form of a domino. Also, notice that there is kind of a mini rolling pin included in your kit which can also be used to flatten the plasticine, carve into it and/or press the raffia and tissue papers into the plasticine.
