

Step 4: *What does a tree look like to you?* Start adding the raffia and tissue papers to the plasticine defining the design of your Domino Tree Painting. Decide whether you would like to create a scenery for your tree and think of the possibility of giving it a seasonal feel or simply focus on shaping a tree. Feel free to layer the raffia and tissue paper and use the second plasticine colour to help build up the layers.



Step 5: Once you have created your scenery on this side of your domino, what design comes to mind for the other side of the tree? Carmen Haakstad put the word Domino there, however, you are free to complete your Domino Tree Painting the way you imagine it.



Step 6: Cut out the label provided and title your sculpted Domino Tree Painting and find a place in your home to display your artwork.
